Jack Brabham started circuit racing in 1953, first came to Britain in 1955 and helped John and Charles Cooper to make the first rear-engined Formula 1 car. He drove for Cooper Car Company in Formula 2 with great success in 1957. He first became World Champion in 1959 driving a Cooper-Coventry Climax. In 1960 he was again World Champion winning five grandes epreuves. In 1961 he drove the first rear-engined car at Indianapolis and was placed ninth. In 1962 he formed his own company and laid the foundations of the string of successes that have been enjoyed by drivers of Brabhams throughout the world, in all classes of Formula Racing and in the Sports Racing Cars of recent years. During 1966, Jack Brabham has scored 42 points in the World Championship series. He has been even more successful in Formula 2 racing and in both fields he has driven a car of his own manufacture. Supporting the skill of Jack Brabham as a driver, is the team work of Phil Kerr (Team Manager), Ron Tauranac (Designer), the skilled mechanics and the reliability of the Repco-Brabham and Honda engines.
